





Randolph Dining Table

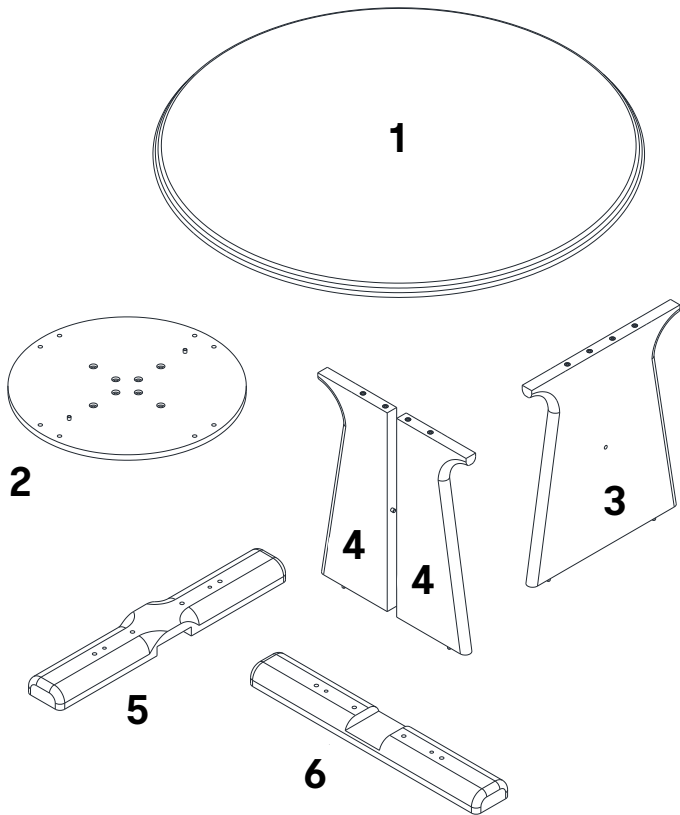
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

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Read these instructions carefully and keep for future reference. Refer to parts inventory for guidance, and ensure you have all pieces before starting. When assembling, place all parts on a soft, clean, and flat surface such as a carpet to prevent scratches.

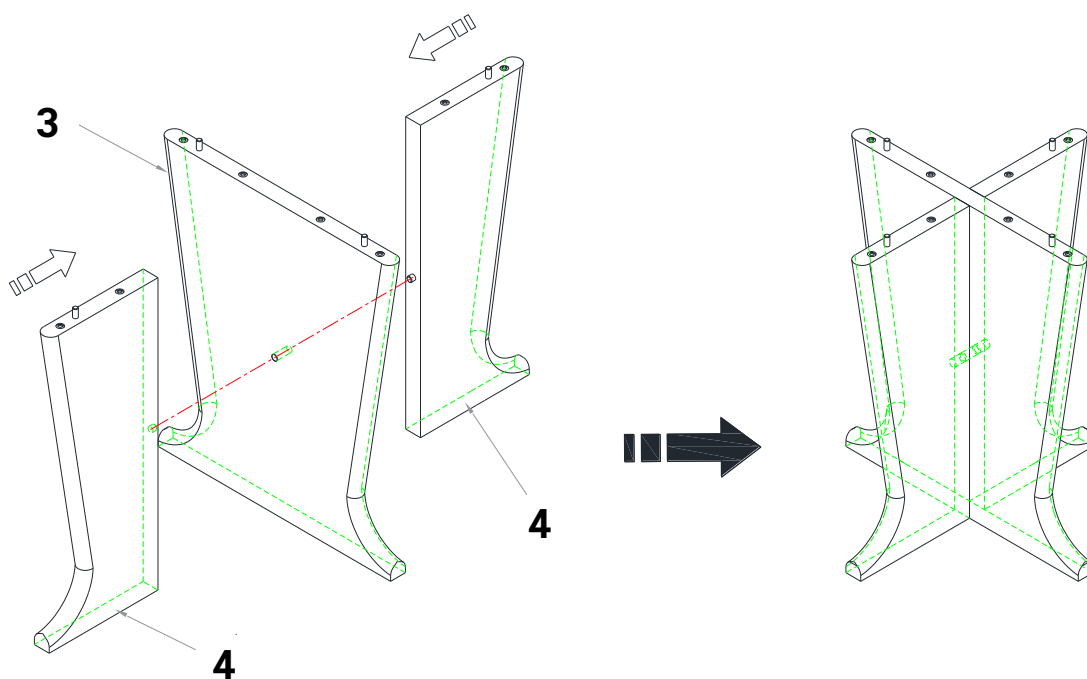

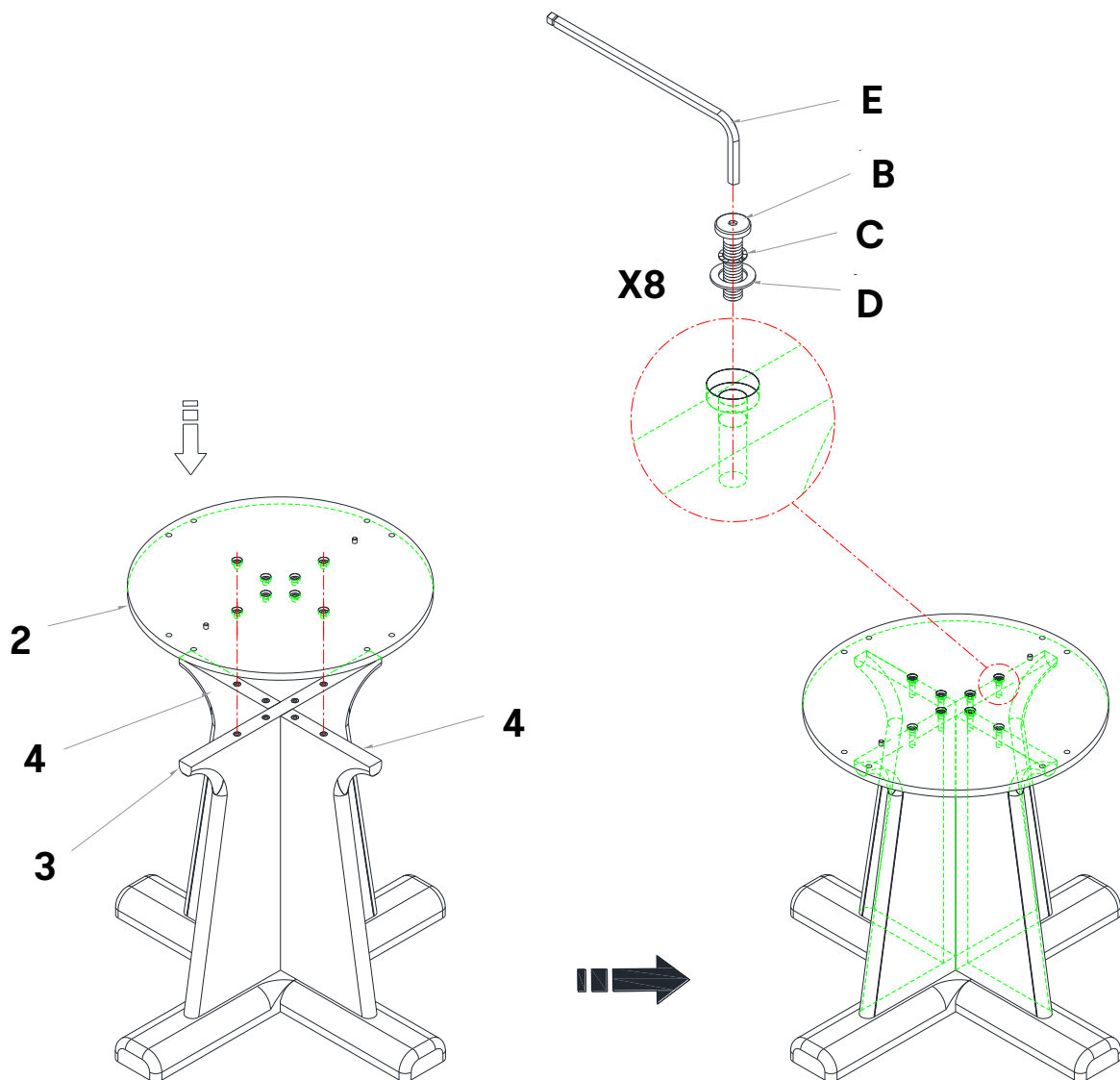
STEP 1

Place the **SMALL POST (4)** onto the **LARGE POST (3)**, making sure the **SMALL POST (4)** and **LARGE POST (3)** are perpendicular and tight.



STEP 3

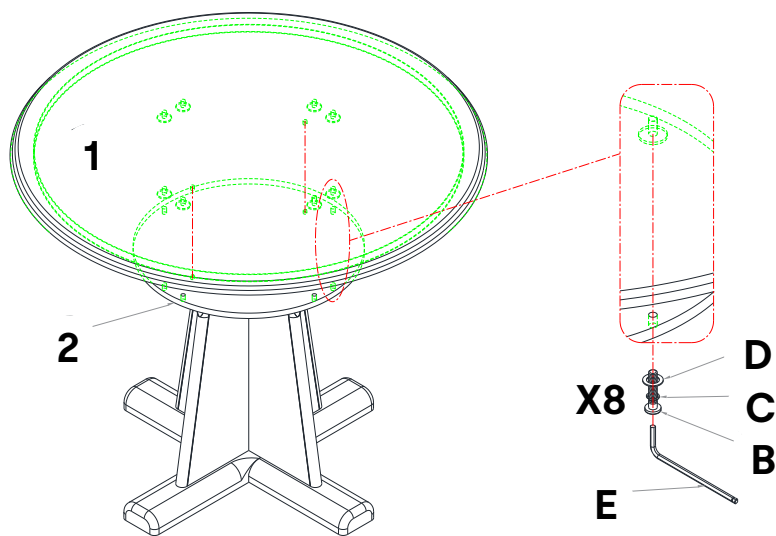
Place the **MOUNTING PANEL (2)** onto the **POST (3) (4)**, making sure the bolt holes are aligned. Slide **LOCK WASHER (C)**, and then **FLAT WASHER (D)** onto **ALLEN BOLT (B)**. Ensure the bolt holes on the **MOUNTING PANEL (2)** match up with the **POST (3) (4)** and attach using **ALLEN WRENCH (E)**, to screw in **ALLEN BOLT (B)**. Repeat this for all remaining bolts.



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STEP 4

Place the **TOP (1)** onto the **MOUNTING PANEL (2)**, making sure the bolt holes are aligned. Slide **LOCK WASHER (C)**, and then **FLAT WASHER (D)** onto **ALLEN BOLT (B)**. Ensure the bolt holes on the **MOUNTING PANEL (2)** match up with the **TOP (1)** and attach using **ALLEN WRENCH (E)**, to screw in **ALLEN BOLT (B)**. Repeat this for all remaining bolts.



STEP 5

The **LEVELING GLIDE (F)** is located at the bottom of the base, so when you place the furniture in the right position, you can adjust the **LEVELING GLIDES** depending on the surface. Make sure it is level and stable. Once your table is level, the assembly is complete.
