

## Bahia Mirror

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### ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

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Read these instructions carefully and keep for future reference. Refer to parts inventory for guidance, and ensure you have all pieces before starting. When assembling, place all parts on a soft, clean, and flat surface such as a carpet to prevent scratches.

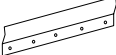

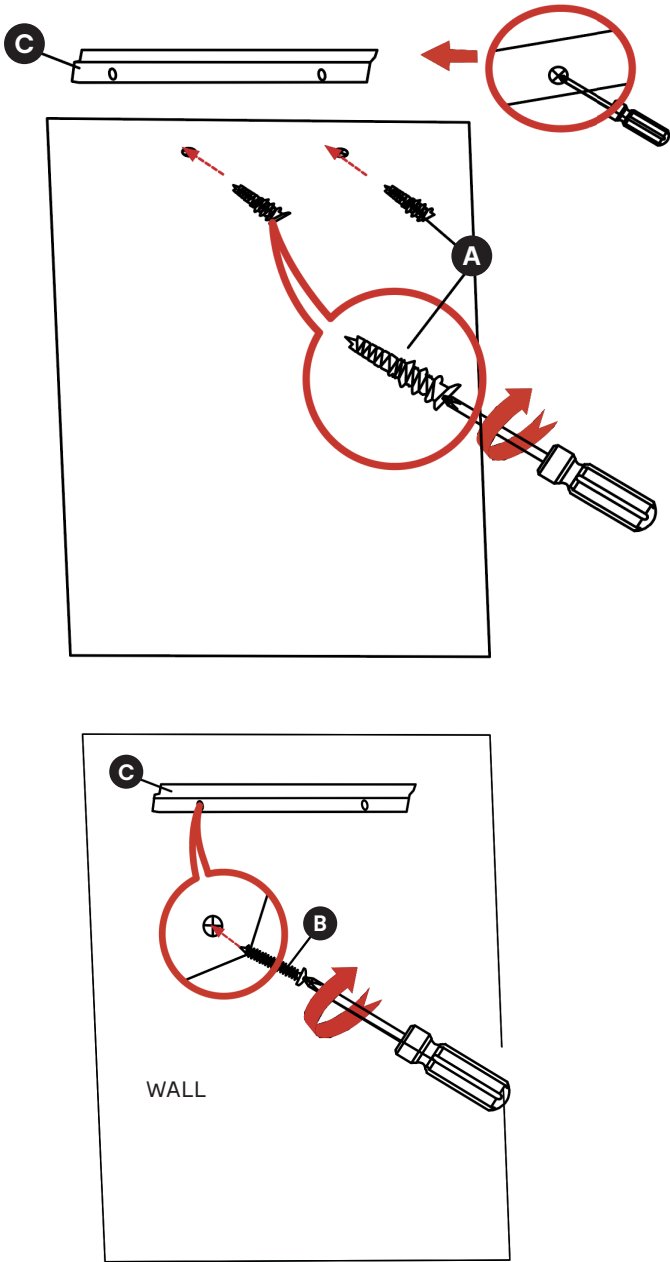
STEP 1

Mark the location of the **CLEAT (C)** holes on the wall and insert **ANCHORS (A)**. Tighten with screwdriver or drill (not included).

STEP 2

Place the **CLEAT (C)** on the wall in it's desired loctation. Ensure the **CLEAT (C)** is level and mark the location of the screw holes. If attaching to drywall, insert **ANCHORS (A)** into the wall at the marked hole locations, then insert **SCREWS (B)** through the **CLEAT (C)** holes and into the **ANCHORS (A)**. Tighten with a phillips head screwdriver. If screwing into studs, no **ANCHORS (A)** are required.

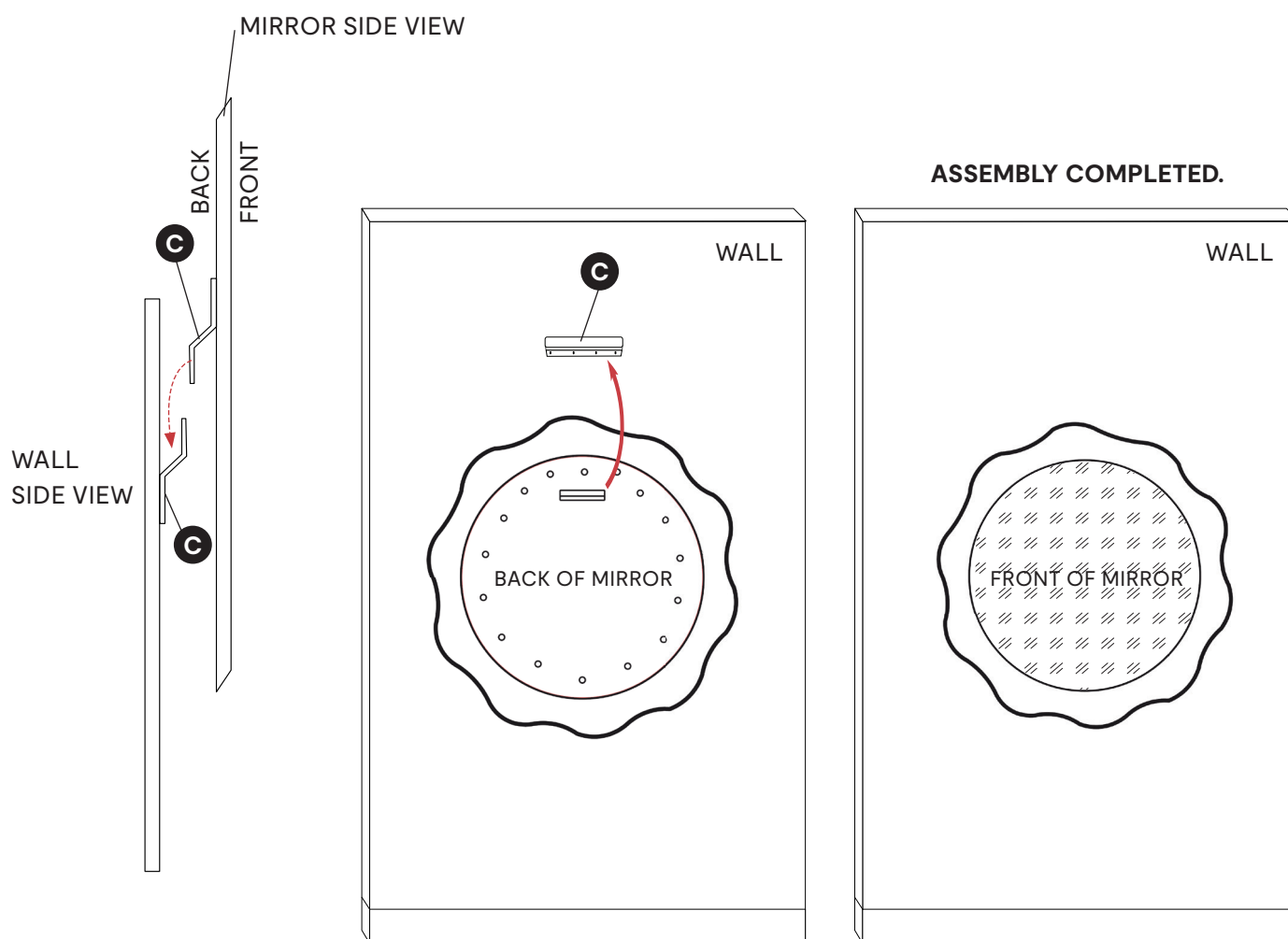
\*Parts not included: Phillips head screwdriver/drill, Pencil, Level, Stud Finder.

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## STEP 3

With help, hang the **MIRROR (1)** onto the **CLEAT (C)** that is attached to the wall, via the **CLEAT (C)** already attached to the **MIRROR (1)** to complete assembly.



## CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Avoid direct exposure to sunlight. Do not place over heat or air conditioning vents. Wipe ideally with a soft cotton cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals. Before cleaning any part, test a small spot in a hidden area. You may need to re-tighten all screws after initial use.
