⚠ SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

These instructions are provided for your safety. It is very important that they are read carefully and completely before beginning the assembly and installation of this lamp. This lamp has been rated for up to one (1) 40-watt maximum standard incandescent light bulb (included). To avoid the risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended wattage. This lamp is meant for indoor use. DRY LOCATION ONLY. **SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS.**

⚠ WARNING

TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRICAL SHOCK OR PERSONAL INJURY, ALWAYS TURN OFF AND UNPLUG THE LAMP AND ALLOW IT TO COOL PRIOR TO REPLACING THE LIGHT BULB.

DO NOT TOUCH BULB WHEN THE LAMP IS TURNED ON. DO NOT LOOK DIRECTLY AT LIT BULB.

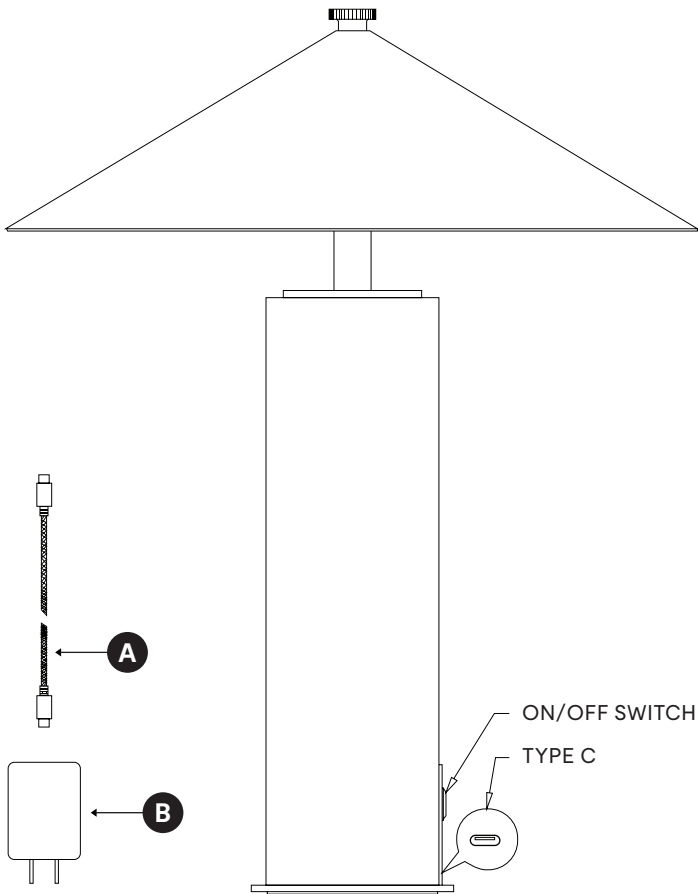
KEEP FLAMMABLE MATERIALS AWAY FROM LIT BULB.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Remove all parts and hardware from box along with any plastic protective packaging.

Do not discard any contents until after assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Carefully remove the fixture from its packaging and connect it using the provided **USB-C CABLE (A)** and **WALL CHARGER (B)**. Make sure the product is fully charged before its first use.
 - Solid Red: Fixture is charging.
 - Solid Green: Fixture is fully charged.
 2. Turn the switch on the fixture assembly to turn the fixture on/off.
 3. Battery disposal should be in compliance with any local regulations that address the disposal of hazardous materials. Do not incinerate.
 4. This device complies with Part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions:
 - (1) This device may not cause harmful interference.
 - (2) This device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.
 5. Changes or modifications not expressly approved by the party responsible for compliance could void the user's authority to operate the equipment.
